### 3. Intended purposes of the collection and usage of the data

TKS Telepost-Kabelservice Kaiserslautern GmbH & Co. KG collects and uses personal data to the extent necessary for the provision of telecommunications services and for the implementation of the contract. Any use or transmission of the inventory data to third parties beyond the stated purpose is subject to the consent of the participant. The inventory data is collected exclusively from the participant.

### 4. Affected groups of persons and categories of data

Inventory data, fee data, traffic and usage data of customers  
Employee and applicant data  
Data of suppliers and owners of rented buildings and real estate insofar as it is necessary for the fulfilment of the purposes set out under 3  
Images of individuals produced during CCTV surveillance of real property.

### 5. Recipients or categories of recipients who the data may be shared with

- Public or external bodies to whom data is imparted due to statutory provisions (e.g. law enforcement authorities)
- Internal departments that are involved in the implementation of the respective business processes (HR, bookkeeping, accounting, purchasing, marketing, sales, telecommunications and IT)
- External contractors (service providers) in accordance with section 11 BDSG handling payments, storage and processing of data, etc.
- Postal and parcel services
- Providers of directories (telephone directory)
- Credit report agencies (Schufa Holding AG, Bürgel Wirtschaftsinformationen GmbH & Co. KG)
- Mobile phone operators who participate in the respective telecommunication

### 6. Regular time limits for the deletion of the data

The data will be deleted following the expiry of the statutory or contractually agreed retention and storage periods. If data is not affected by this, it will be deleted once the purposes listed under 3 have lapsed.

### 7. Data transfer to third countries

In the context of agreements between mobile phone companies, data required for the provision of the service and for purposes of invoicing is transferred to third countries, also outside the EU.
