## 1. Ethernet connection [off-base]



Plug one end of the **ETHERNET** cable into the set-top box's **LAN** port, the other end into a free **Ethernet** port on your modem router.

NOTE: Please do not connect the set-top box's power cord at this time.

## 2. HDMI

Connect one end of the **HDMI** cable to the set-top box, and the other to your television set.



## 3. Power-up

- Connect the supplied AC power adapter to the set-top box and turn on your television set.
- Turn on your easyTV set-top box by pressing the remote's red power button.



## 4. Initial startup

**Television Set** - Using your TV's remote control select the set-top box as the input source. Your set-top box will automatically initialize when turned on for the first time, this may take a few minutes. The easyTV welcome screen and main menu will appear indicating that your service is now ready to use.

## 5. Select a channel and start watching!

Your easyTV setup is now complete. To select or change channels, press the **SFI** key to display the on-screen program guide. You can also flip up or down through channels by pressing the **+ / - PROG** keys.

**TIP:** If at any time the main picture or on-screen menu freezes or becomes unresponsive, unplug the set-top box from the power and then reconnect. This reboots the set-top box and will clear most problems.
